while on retreat this past spring I spent a lot of time in prayer reflecting on the state of our amazing parish. I found myself being filled with gratitude as I was contemplating all that we do and all that we have accomplished together as a parish family. Thank you to everyone for all that you do to make this place so special!

While on retreat in Illinois I purposely visited a different parish each weekend dressed in street clothes. I did not feel welcomed at any of the parishes. The experience made me appreciate even more the welcoming spirit of St. Louis the King. People who visit us almost always remark how welcoming our parish is. Thank you for all that you do to make that happen.

As pastor I am grateful for the spiritual growth that I see blossoming in so many of you. I know that I am growing closer to the Lord each day and I see many of you on that same path. I thank God everyday for the gift of the Holy Spirit that I feel moving among us.

This past year we celebrated the payoff of our building debt. It was a good feeling to see the mortgage reduced to a pile of ashes. We all should be filled with gratitude for those who have gone

before us with the vision and the commitment that resulted in such a beautiful and functional building and grounds complex. I cannot think of a better layout. Our beautiful church building, with the two halls, kitchen, narthex, classrooms, offices and grounds is a perfect place to worship together and to build community and fellowship. Many of you continue to support our building needs with contributions. The parish Women's Club and our local Knights of Columbus Council continue to contribute each year to our building fund. Thank you!

This past year the finance committee engaged the parish in a planning process to develop and prioritize buildings and grounds upkeep and improvements. It is now up to us to maintain and build on the vision of those who have gone before us. We must work together to assure the continued growth of Christ's Church and the fulfillment of His mission. The diocese has requested that we formulate a more detailed capital plan and reduce that plan to a written "Case Statement." We are in the process of developing this and hope to present it to the parish soon.

For the third straight year we exceeded our UPCSA goal. This year was a bit of a struggle and

we did not reach our goal until the end of December. As a parish we supported many causes including various diocesan, local, national and world wide efforts. On August 25th we celebrated the feast day of our patron saint and followed his example with a community meal and gave away over \$1,000 worth of backpacks and school supplies. We serviced our community with Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets through our 333 fund which exceeded \$3,400 for the year. We also supplied \$14,615 to our local St. Vincent de Paul Conference.

In terms of the operating budget of the parish we noticed, as I am sure all of you have, rather significant increases in utility costs this past year. As we grow we also are in need of additional staffing to meet the needs of our growing parish. We continue to add families with children, and so our needs for youth ministry and catechesis have grown. For the first time in many years we will have high school students celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation this spring. With that in mind we felt that it was necessary to hire a more "full-time" youth minister.

I pray that each of us will continue to grow closer to the Lord and that we will all continue to live out the mission Christ has entrusted to us. May God bless you all!
